

ADVANCED FINISHING TECHNIQUES

None of the fabrics in your samples have to be coordinated. Use your scraps and leftovers from other projects. These mini-quilts will be technical reminders for you when you need a special finish to your quilt.

Five 8" square quilts finished as follows:

One finished with quilting 1" from the outside edges

Four finished with edge to edge quilting – they can be spray basted

Eight 3" squares of fabric for prairie points

72 inches of bias binding, cut 2 ½" wide, folded wrong sides together and pressed

36 inches of a straight grain strip cut 1 ½" wide, folded wrong sides together and pressed

Sewing Machine with walking foot

Sewing supplies for machine work

Straight pins

Scissors

Note taking supplies
