

Clothesline Bags and Boxes

Supplies:

1. The pattern for your clothesline project (one of the Aunties Two patterns)
2. Bali Pop or equivalent
3. Clothesline- 2 hanks for most projects
4. Simplicity 1 ¼" bias tape maker
5. Sewing machine with accessories and manual
6. Rotary equipment (bring an assortment of rulers)
7. Basic sewing supplies(thread, scissors-paper and fabric, pins, etc)
8. Cotton thread – 50- weight is preferred (several spools of coordinating color)
9. Sewing machine needles: 90/14 (bring several packages)
10. Measuring tape
11. Two medium to large tote bags (like the reusable grocery totes)

Pre-class Preparation:

1. For all the patterns you will need to do the pressing before class.
2. If you are doing the Bali Bag, you will need to sew 30 strips together (end to end-making a very long strip) before you press.
3. Press these strips so that it looks like single fold bias tape (if you have questions about this just ask). This is where the 1 ¼" bias tape maker is used. It makes things very easy. If you don't know how to use it, ask and we can demo.
