Following is the supply list for the first session. At each class you will be given the supply list for the following month.

Barbara's Antique Table Runner

Pattern: Barbara's Antique by Debbie McCaffey (supplied by instructor)

Sewing machine IN GOOD WORKING ORDER

¼" presser foot to fit your machine (Bernina #37 or #57)

Embroidery weight thread in neutral color (Aurifil recommended)

Cutting Mat

Rotary Cutter

6 ½"x 24" or 8 ½" x 24" rotary ruler (6 ½" and 12 ½" squares are helpful if available)

Small scissors for cutting threads

Seam ripper (optional)

Fabric:

Light – ½ yd

Main Print & backing – 1 ½ yds

Binding – 3/8 yd

If you wish to cut before coming to class you may do the following:

Strips are cut across the width of the fabric (approx 42")

Light:

Cut one strip 6 ½" wide, then cut into four 6 ½" squares

Cut five strips 1 ½" wide

Main Print:

Cut fabric in half lengthwise, parallel to selvage to make two panels approximately 21"x54". Set one panel aside for the backing.

From second panel, cut the following:

Cut six strips 2 ½" wide (across the width of the fabric) making them about 2 ½" x 21"

Cut three 2 ½" wide strips down the length of the remaining fabric, approx. 42". Reserve these for the border.

Cut ten 3 ½" squares from left over fabric.
