- *Alex Anderson's Hand & Machine Appliqué*
- Paper scissors
- Small, sharp scissors that cut to the point
- Pencils to mark on your fabric *e.g. chalk, silver, mechanical*
- Template plastic both regular and heat resistant (only small pieces of each)
- Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Circles (regular size)
- Freezer paper, Reynolds brand is best
- Water-soluble glue stick
- Materials as listed on page 29 of the required book
- Cotton or silk thread in colors to match your applique fabrics
- Applique needles, I suggest size 10 sharps or milliners
- Clover Desk Needle Threader (optional)
- Sequin pins (I prefer the ¾" length)
- A snack, if you wish
