

SUPPLY LIST FOR BEGINNING HAND APPLIQUE

- *Hand Applique with Alex Anderson.*
- Two Xerox copies of the design on page 26 and clear contact paper OR freezer paper and light weight cardboard (e.g. file folder)
- Paper scissors
- Pencils to mark on your fabric *e.g. chalk, silver, mechanical*
- Template plastic both regular and heat resistant (only small pieces of each)
- Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Circles (regular size)
- Freezer paper, Reynolds brand is best
- Water soluble glue stick
- Background fabric either a 17" by 19" rectangle OR pieced according to the directions on page 23 in the book, you may use the yardage listed on page 22
- Applique fabrics in your choice of colors – Yardage is listed on page 22
- Cotton thread in colors to match your applique fabrics
- Small, sharp scissors that cut to the point
- Applique needles
- Sequin pins (I prefer the ¾" length)
- A snack, if you wish
