

## Color Mastery Supplies:

### Supplies:

- Fabric scraps; lots. Pre-cut into 2" squares.(as many as you can). Students will also cut additional fabric in. Fabrics should encompass all types and styles as well as a full gamut of color, value and intensity.
- More fabrics in class = more color to study.
- Freezer paper pre-cut into sheets. 8 1/2"x 11" is a nice uniform size, plus you can purchase packets in this size. Each student should plan for at least 20 sheets.
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler. Small set up (8 1/2" x 11" or similar size.) Bring at least one smaller ruler to easily cut 2" squares. A 4" or/and 6" square ruler will enable cutting multiples.

Also consider bringing Fabrics that you are working with and would like critique or input.

- Quilts you would like to discuss.
- Pencil and note taking supplies.

## Session I – The One (or two) color quilt

Working with your color “stash”, explore the pairing of color, hue and value to plan a quilt, quilt square or simply paste ups. One color plus background as well as complementary colors will be discussed.

- Bring show and share any quilts that fit into this category, or quilts you question.
