

**Diamond Island Tote**  
**Kathy Lincoln**

**Supplies:**

1. Pattern: Diamond Island Tote by Aunties Two
2. Fabric: Jelly Roll, Bali Pop, or 38 – 2 ½” strips AND 1 ½ yd of coordinating fabric.
3. Batting– 1 ¼ yd
4. Stiff interfacing – Craf-tex #337 – 1 yd
5. Piping- ¼”- 7yds
6. Cotton thread – 50- weight is preferred (several spools of coordinating color); wind several bobbins, this will save class time.
7. Sewing machine needles: either 90/14 or 100/16 (bring several packages)
8. Sewing machine with accessories and manual
9. Rotary equipment (large ruler- 16” square is helpful)
10. Basic sewing supplies(thread, scissors-paper and fabric, pins, etc)
11. Freezer paper
12. Fast-Turn tool is very helpful

**Pre-class Preparation:**

1. Batting- cut 28 - 2 ½” X 22” strips and 1 – 8” X 35” rectangle.
2. From the coordinating fabric cut 1 – 16” X 35”, 1 – 24” X 35”, 1 – 8” X 44”
