

Ghost Star

Designed as a Mystery, this original quilt by Lesly-Claire Greenberg is a canvas for color transparencies. Simple stars are layered in various sizes which allows the colors to mix in new shades, values and hues. Quilt is 60" square without borders.

The fabric selection is vital to success. Read the following list, written with suggested colors to show how the fabrics will "mix", as if paint was actually stirred. You may choose to work with value gradation, shading from dark to light or the reverse. Some artistic license may be used.

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric 1: White 1 yard.

Fabric 2: Yellow 1 ½ yard. Largest area of quilt/ Background.

Fabric 3: Blue ¾ yard.

Fabric 4: Green 1 yard.

Fabric 5: Pink ¾ yard.

Fabric 6: Orange 1 yard.

Fabric 7: Purple ½ yard.

Fabric 8: Deep Green ½ yard.

Visualize the following & use as a guide:

Fabrics 2 & 3 mix to make Fabric 4.

Fabrics 2 & 5 mix to make Fabric 6.

Fabrics 3 & 5 mix to make Fabric 7.

Fabrics 2, 3, & 4 mix to make Fabric 8.

Other Supplies:

Sewing Machine in good working order, with all its parts.

Pins

Seam ripper

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler. 6" x 24", 4" x 14", 6 ½" square. If you have particular favorites bring them.

¼" patchwork foot.

Marking pencil for light and dark fabrics.

The "Angler"™ if you have/use.

Everything you can't work without.
