

## QUILTING BY HAND

### **Session 1**

18" x 22" or any size up to 27", white or off white muslin, prewashed and preironed for top

22" x 26" or any size up to 31", same fabric or contrast, prewashed and preironed for backing

Quilting thread to match

Basting thread or inexpensive white thread

low-loft poly batting of a size between the sizes of your top and backing fabrics

14" hoop (16" if you are very tall, 12" if you are very short)

Quilting needles size 10

Sharps needles for basting, any size, the longer the better, John James #7 Darners are good

Needle threader (optional)

Thimble to fit middle finger of your dominant hand

Fabric scissors

Thread cutters

Fine point pencil (mechanical or very sharp regular)

Masking tape

### **Session 2**

Border stencil, 1 1/2" to 3" wide, your choice of design

Plain paper (tracing or other) 22" square or to tape together

Ruler

### **Session 3**

Quilt top to discuss
