Lesly-Claire has designed over 60 original thematic quilts that have delighted mystery quilt classes for more than 15 years. Enjoy an easy paced class with precise pattern and step by step written directions.

Join me for a Mystery trip on the old Santa Fe Trail. The finished quilt is 32" x 51".

Fabric Requirements:

Choose 3, to 8 fabrics. Select Light, Medium, and Dark with multiple Mediums; i.e. Medium Light, Medium, and Medium Dark. 1 ¾ yards to 2 yards of each will give you maximum room to "Play" with your colors.

Color suggestions: (Hint!) Consider a rich tan for Light; Turquoise, Red and Brown for the Mediums; Black or Dark Green for the Dark. Dark Green, Red, Black and Yellow, OR Shades of Red, Orange, Yellow, and Green.

My Sample is in Cherrywood Sueded Cottons. Brick, Burgundy, Tan, Fawn, Medium Green, Dark Green, and Turquoise.

Sewing machine in good working order, with all its parts.

¼" patchwork presser foot

Pins

Seam Ripper

Thread

Needles

Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler. 4" x 14" and 6" or 6 ½" x 24; Optional: 4", 6", 9", 12" or 15" squares, with or without the added ½", if you have them it makes life easier. Any or all.
