

## Simple Gifts Supply List

- Pattern
- 3 yards background fabric – washed and pressed
- 2 yards fabric for vines, some leaves, and accent “Lattice”
- 2 yards fabric for border
- Template plastic
- Applique pins
- Sharpie with extra fine tip
- Small scissors with micro tip
- Milliners or straw needles size #10 or #11
- Needle threader (optional)
- Assorted thread to match applique
- Karen K Buckley’s Perfect Circles or Circle-eeze
- Hera marker
- Masking tape
- White marking pen
- Freezer paper on the roll or the printer-friendly sheets
- Thimble (optional)
- Assorted tidbits and FQ’s in a range of colors and value (light, medium, and dark). Also, some interesting textures for bugs and bug wings.
- Embroidery floss and beads for applique embellishment.
- Light box or good window!!!

For the first class, come with block #1 background cut out (17” x 20”). If possible, overcast or zigzag the raw edges to prevent fraying. Bring your fabric choices for leaves, violets, and dragonfly.
