

## Walking the Curve

1. Sewing machine in good working order
2. Walking foot to fit your machine (For Bernina: dual sole walking foot #50)
3. Single hole stitch plate is highly recommended. (Also called a straight stitch needleplate or throat plate)
4. Large-eyed self-threading hand sewing needles
5. Brass Stiletto (Please identify yours prior to class.)
6. Small snips such as Havel's Eze-Snips used in machine embroidery
7. Quilting thread with matching bobbin thread. Bobbin thread should be lighter weight than quilting thread. I will be using 50 weight in the bobbin and 30 weight on top. Please do sample stitching to balance tension before class.
8. Fabric sandwich with one side plain or plain print, muslin is fine. It should be cut no larger than 15" x 24". Spray Baste using cotton batting, Dream Cotton Select recommended.
9. Thimble if you use one for hand sewing
